We had our Year 6 Graduation Ceremony and Prom this week. It was a fantastic send off. We wish all our Year 6 students all the best for the future.


#### DRAGON BOAT RACE

#### SCHOOL MEAL PRICE INCREASE

The cost of a school meal at West Primary School has been held very successfully for a few years now at £2.00 per lunch. However, despite our best efforts, this price does not enable us to cover the total cost of the school meals provided. Unfortunately, this means that we must raise the cost. We did explore other alternatives but unfortunately to subsidise school meals from other areas of our stretched budget would mean that money available for teaching and learning would be impacted. **As a result, our Full Governing Body has approved an increase in the cost of a school meal from September 2018 to £2.20 per lunch.** This change will not affect children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 who are entitled to receive a free meal through the Universal Free School Meal system. It will also not affect children in Years 3-6 who have access to Free School Meals due to their family circumstances.

### **Ofsted Inspection**

I am pleased to write to you on behalf of the Board of Governors to inform you of the outcome of our Ofsted Inspection on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> June 2018. The visit was the first short inspection carried out since the school was judged to be 'Good' in September 2014. The headline is that the school continues to be 'Good'.
